Please do not drive or walk around roads that have been coned, taped or barricaded off. These are marking hazards that may include power lines being down across the road. Further, please do not climb or play in or near trees that have fallen as they may have power lines entangled in them.

We hope to see our community out tonight enjoying the weather and this fun time. Please remain safe, have fun and be vigilant of possible hazards left behind by the storm.
